

A Living Tradition

I think that when most of us hear the word tradition, we think of something set or rigid. Whether it is “this is the way that we have always done it,” or “that is the way that it was.” Our idea of tradition can be a little bit narrow in our definition.

A book that I have been reading is *Reclaiming Vatican II* by Fr. Blake Britton. In there he talks about tradition as a living, dynamic part of our faith. The word “tradition” comes from a Latin verb *tradere* which means “to hand on” or “to hand over.” Another way to think about this was that tradition was often seen as one generation handing on their wisdom to the next. All this is to say that our tradition is not a rigid and stagnant set of rules and regulations, but it is a vast treasure of wisdom and beauty that has been amassed by our forebearers.

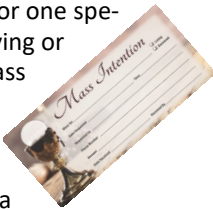
