A Living Tradition


I think that when most of us hear the word tradition, we think of something set or rigid. Whether it is "this is the way that we have always done it," or "that is the way that it was." Our idea of tradition can be a little bit narrow in our definition.

A book that I have been reading is *Reclaiming Vatican II* by Fr. Blake Britton. In there he talks about tradition as a living, dynamic part of our faith. The word "tradition" comes from a Latin verb *tradere* which means "to hand on" or "to hand over." Another way to think about this was that tradition was often seen as one generation handing on their wisdom to the next. All this is to say that our tradition is not a rigid and stagnant set of rules and regulations, but it is a vast treasure of wisdom and beauty that has been amassed by our forebearers.

I bring this up not only because the book is an excellent read, but also

to show people a little of what you may see different priests doing. Some of you may have gone to other parishes where you see priests using incense, chalice veils, chant, cassocks, or any variety of other things. You may wonder, "is Father trying to turn back

the clock to before Vatican II" and the truth is no. Rather, what I have come to see from myself, and many younger priests is a desire to dig through our tradition. It is a desire to dig through the vast riches that are in our tradition. We look for those things that can help to best convey the richness and beauty that are present in the mass that we pray each week. It is looking for those signs, symbols, and words that will help us all to understand and glory in the miracle that happens on the altar before us.


