Time with Jesus

This Sunday we celebrate Laetare Sunday which means “rejoice.” It comes from the entrance antiphon for Sunday’s mass which is, “Rejoice Jerusalem...” This rejoicing is because we are past the halfway point of Lent, and we are looking forward to Holy Week.

During Holy Week we will have some special opportunities to spend time with our Lord. The first is that I will be working to do 24 hours of Eucharistic adoration from 5pm on Wednesday, April 16th to 5pm on Thursday April 17th. I will be bringing the signup sheet to the parishes on the weekend masses, please consider signing up for a 1-hour slot.

Another opportunity to spend time with our Lord will be when he is placed in the altar of repose (located in St. Joseph’s hall or parish office). The Church calls for the tabernacle in the Church to be empty from the end of the Holy Thursday mass to sometime on Saturday before the Easter Vigil begins. We go to visit the Lord in the altar of repose to “keep watch” with him at the Mount of Olives. We will have extended times on the evening of Holy Thursday after mass and Good Friday where the office will be kept open for people to come visit the Lord. I will post the hours in a later bulletin. I invite all of you to consider taking a little extra time to be with the Lord during our Holy Week liturgies.
