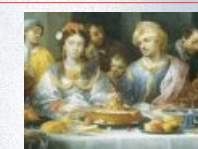

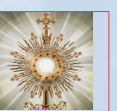

Bishops website at www.usccb.org.

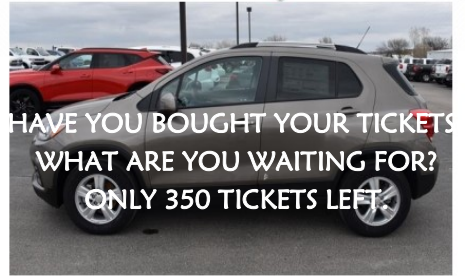
