Sacred Relics of the Saints Tour Treasures of the Church, presented by Fr. Carlos Martins of the Companions of the Cross, is an exposition of relics beginning with a multi-media presentation that is scriptural, catechetical, and devotional. After the presentation, those in attendance will have the opportunity to venerate some 150 relics, including those of St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. The supreme highlights are one of the largest relics of the True Cross in the world, and a piece of the Veil that is believed to have belonged to Our Lady. The veneration of relics is a communion with the heroes of our Christian faith, asking for their powerful intercession.
