

When I stand before Jesus

When I die, do not give me a celebration of life service. Pray for my soul! There is a mindset in our culture today. It is the assumption that when a person dies, they automatically go to heaven. There are several reasons behind this. One is that our culture does not live well, nor do we know how to deal with death. Another, it is more comfortable to think of our loved ones immediately brought into heaven than waiting in purgatory.

This is not the mindset of the Church. While we do not know the state of each person's soul, we know that nothing imperfect can enter heaven. The soul must be purified of all earthly and sinful attachments before it can stand to be face to face with God in heaven. This is the great blessing of purgatory; it is a place of final purification for the soul that is not yet ready for heaven. The funeral mass is primarily to pray for the one who has died, that by our prayers he or she may be quickly purified and made ready for heaven. While purgatory is a great blessing, it is not a comfortable process of being purified.

I can safely speak for myself that I am a beloved son of the Father who has many faults that need to be corrected and healed. I pray that I will cooperate well with God's grace here and now to be purified of those faults. However, when I die, the thing that I want most of all from those who love me are prayers and masses offered for my soul. I want those who have loved and assisted me in life to not stop assisting me when I am gone. (I have no reason that I know of to believe that I will stand before Jesus soon, yet I want to be ready all the same).

It is important to share memories and stories of those we love who have died. However, we do them a greater service by continuing to pray for them. It is important to have a funeral mass prayed for the person so that the community can gather to pray for him or her. It is also a great act of love to continue to pray and have masses offered for him or her.

I know that I am a beloved son, deeply loved by God, who is also a great sinner in need of God's mercy. So, when I go stand before Jesus, I do not want people to talk about how good a man I was. I want people to pray for me, to beg God to pour out his mercy upon me so that I may enter eternal communion with God in heaven. I want people to tell Jesus, "Yes Lord, we know that he was a bonehead. Yes, he did do those foolish things. But Lord, he is your bonehead that you love, so be merciful in judging his actions. J" So, when I die, whether it be tomorrow or seventy years from now, do not have a Celebration of Life service for me, but give me a funeral mass with all the trimmings to pray that I may be forgiven of all my faults. Amen.

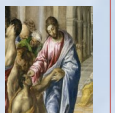
