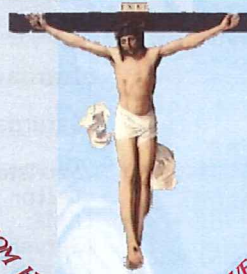

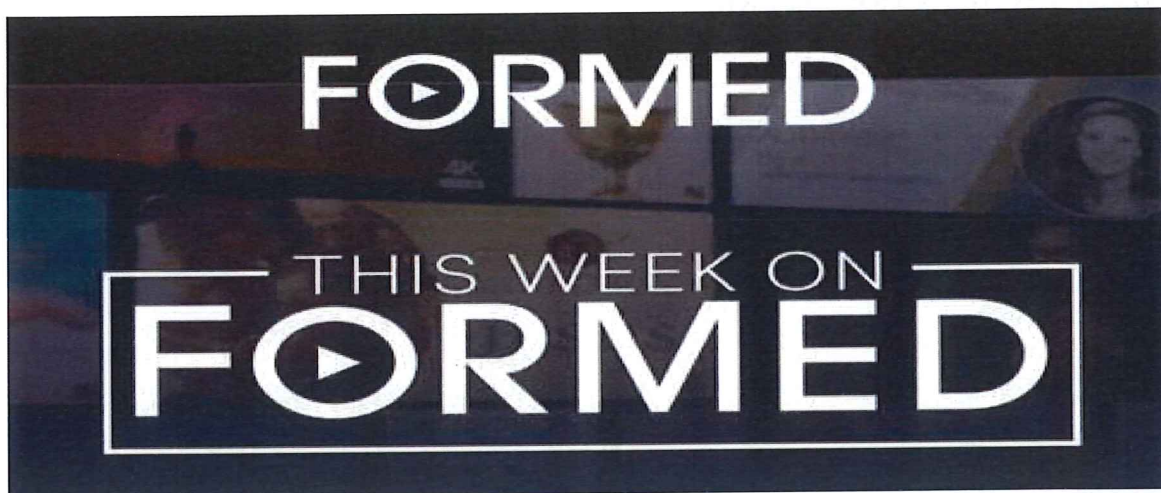

To sign-up for formed using our parish account, just follow the simple instructions below:

1. Go to formed.org/signup
2. Search for your parish by Zip Code (57580). Click on Immaculate Conception Church.
3. Register with your name and email address
4. Check that email account for a link to begin using FORMED

Once you have signed up, the sign-in process is simple as well:

Please visit watch.formed.org and click on Sign In (upper, right hand corner). Enter your email, then check your email inbox for a link to click on, to complete the Sign In process, and begin enjoying FORMED. I stay signed in because when a parishioner forwards me a link to a Formed program, I can simply click on the link and access the material quickly.

Formed can be accessed on almost any platform including Android (Play Store), IOS (Apple App Store), web browsers, Roku, Chromecast, FireTV and Apple TV.
