

St. Joseph, Head of the Holy Family

We hold up St. Joseph as a model for Fathers and all men; yet I think that some of the art of the Church does not do him justice. When I have seen many images or statues of St. Joseph, it is as an old man with white beard and all. While the Church gives no definitive answer, I think that it is a more powerful image of him being young, strong, and full of life.

In the book, Consecration to St. Joseph, there is a chapter titled, “old men do not walk to Egypt.” The concise point of this is the following. From Nazareth to Bethlehem is around 80 miles across the desert wilderness. St Joseph led Mary across that to the stable, then when they had to flee to Egypt which is 40 miles across more rugged terrain from Bethlehem to the Egyptian border. So, St. Joseph not only had to lead his family over 120 miles from Nazareth to Egypt, but then after providing for them in that foreign land, he led them back. It takes a strong, tough, and courageous man to lead his family through the wilderness and dangers to safety.

Fathers in this day and time lead their families through dangerous territory of our world today. There is a spiritual desert in our world that our families need to be led across to the kingdom of God.

“*Ite ad Joseph!*” This Latin phrase is a command, “*Go to Joseph!*” He is the one who can help us lead our families through the dangers of this world and keep them within the safety of Christ’s Church.
