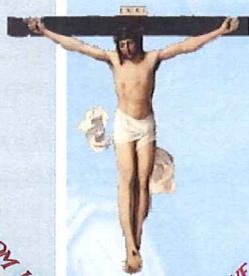

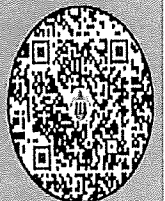
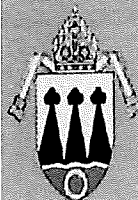

Hunting for Seminarians

This dinner and hunt take place just down the road in Dallas, SD at St. Hubert's Hideaway on October 1-2. The proceeds from this fundraiser go to support the education of our seminarians, such as Deacon Josiah Hanson, who was in our parish last summer. The hunt this year is also an opportunity to meet our new vocations director for the diocese, Father Tyler Dennis, who is no stranger to hunting pheasants.

There are a couple of ways that you can join me in supporting the Bishop's Hunt. The first is to sign up to go on the hunt. It will give you an opportunity to see how well or poorly your pastor shoots, and bragging rights IF you can outshoot him. A second way to support the hunt, if you cannot enter as a hunter, is to register to come to the dinner and social on Thursday night. The dinner is limited to 70 people, so you will not be lost in the crowd. The social starts at 5pm with the dinner and program at 6pm. It is a wonderful meal of brisket and other excellent food that will ensure a fun time for all. 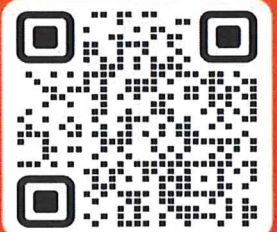
